ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Dale Road, Brantingham

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Dale Road, Brantingham between starting approx 20meters north of the passing place and finishing approx 100meters South of the passing place commencing 26th October 2020 to allow works to improve surface water drainage to take place.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6th November 2020.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Dale Road, Ripplingham Road, Swinescaife Road, Beverley Road, Market Place, Brough Road, South Cave Junction Roundabout, Brantingham Road, Burrill Lane and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicles and pedestrians.
