ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Dale Road Brantingham

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Dale Road Brantingham between All Saints Church and the junction with Beverley Road Riplingham commencing 10th June 2019 at 9:00am to allow tree maintenance works.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 6 hours, (by 15:00hrs on 10th June 2019).

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Dale Road, Burrill Lane Brantingham Road, Brough Road Ellerker, South Cave Junction Roundabout, A1034 Brough Road South Cave, Market Place South Cave, Beverley Road South Cave, Beverley Road Riplingham and vice versa.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic for the duration of these works.
