Item 1 Minutes of the last meeting

These were accepted as a true record and signed by the chairman.

Item 2 Matters arising and outstanding.

Emergency Plan – The plan has been updated and will be approved at the AGM in May. We will also include a photo showing the location of the defibrillator near the church.

Pond – Richard Shillaker reported that the water level in the pond is good. There is a pile of vegetation that needs to be taken away. There is mud on the road, this is running into the pond, this will need digging out. Richard Powell will do this when he installs the new benches. Richard Shillaker has planted some Snowdrops and Primroses near the pond. The New parking signs have now been put up. The hedge at the back of the pond could do to be cut.

Tree Planting –Richard Powell has tried to contact Mike at Ellerker Lodge several times regarding the trees, but he is not returning Richards calls. Anna will call into the centre to asked if the trees are available, if so, we could arrange for collection and plant them ourselves.

Ditch by Village Hall –The ditch has been cleaned out ready for the culvert work to commence. Andrew Milner is liaising with M B Roche Civil Engineering who will undertake the work. A date for this has not yet been given.

Barrier Repair/Bollards near the Beck – We are waiting for a response from ERYC regarding who is responsible for the barrier repair. ERYC has been out to look at the bollard near the beck but could not see the damaged or missing bollard. We need to send a photo to ERYC for them to identify the exact location.

Cave Road – Some progress has been made along Cave Road; ERYC have swept the footpaths. There is some pipe/cable work being conducted on Cave Road and this should take about six weeks to complete. We note that ERYC has taken out three trees from near the notice board.

Brough Town Council are still considering our offer to split the cost of employing a grounds person. They have advertised the position and are struggling to find someone who is willing to do the hours required.

Platinum Jubilee – A public meeting was held on Monday 28th February 2022 to see if people would be interested in putting on an event to celebrate the Jubilee. The meeting was well attended, and it was agreed to hold an event in the Village. (See attached minutes). Another meeting has been arranged for Monday 21st March.

Emma Mountfield has suggested holding a cricket match on the old cricket ground in the village and has kindly offered to arrange a hog roast. This is hoped to take place on the Saturday of the Jubilee weekend. Everyone is in favour of the match, but this would depend on getting enough people to form two teams. We will ask Emma to attend the meeting on the 21st to discuss this further.

The PC has offered to contribute five hundred pounds to help fund the event. ERYC are offering grants to help fund events and Richard Powell has put in an application on behalf of the PC for this. The grant can be up to a maximum of five hundred pounds.

Ukrainian Appeal – Richard Shillaker asked if we should make a contribution to the Ukrainian Appeal. It was felt that we could not use public money for something outside the area but will put a notice on the website encouraging people to help.

Work Party (litter and paths) Richard Shillaker would like to arrange a litter pick, and to clear mud from the footpath towards Ionians (it was suggested he contact Colleen Gill). We usually hold our annual litter pick to coincide with the Great Britton Litter Pick, this is due to take place from 25th March to 10th April 2022. Richard is conscious of asking the same people all the time and this is something that could be advertised on the website and on the Facebook page. Richard will email some suggested dates.

State of track to Church Green - The first entrance to Church Green is becoming a sea of mud. It was suggested to dig out the mud, back to the stone then put some new stones down. Nik suggest using granite chippings.

The track is used regularly as this is the entrance to John Levison's field. Richard Shillaker agreed to speak to the Levisons.

Litter Bin at Cockle Pits layby – Pat Smith has mentioned at a previous meeting the need for a new bin in the Cockle Pits layby. Richard Shillaker has also been approached by someone suggesting a bin for the layby. Richard Meredith will ask Pat if she has taken this any further.

Parish Review – We have received an email from ERYC asking on a preliminary basis whether our parish council is aware of any issues that it wishes to be considered as part of such review. We may need to consider that Brough might like the boundary changed to include Cave Road within their parish. Many people think Cave Road is already part of Brough. If Cave Road became part of Brough this would influence our precept. We feel the residents of Cave Road would not want to see this change. Richard Meredith will raise this at Brough Town Council meeting. This will be discussed at our next meeting. We may want to consider proposing Cave Road as a conservation area. Linda will make enquires.

Defibrillator -We will ask Louise to check battery.
