Item 1 Minutes of the last meeting

The minutes of the meeting held 8th September 2025 were accepted as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

Item 2 Matters arising and outstanding.

Difey Grant/Village Enhancement – Following our application we have been awarded five thousand pounds under the grant scheme and can now move forward with the village enhancements.

The planters for the village green have been ordered from NBB Recycled Plastic. These should be delivered in 3 to 4 weeks. Planter base materials have been ordered.

Steve Murrey of ERYC is happy to re-site the Cave Road notice board.

Richard has spoken to ERYC regarding the site for the new litter bin and has agreed the site for it to be installed.

Ellerker Lodge have the trees in stock we require. We will need plants for the planter once they are installed. Everyone agreed for Richard and Vaida to order suitable plants for the planters.

As part of the grant conditions, we need to keep a record of volunteers who help with the above-mentioned work and need forty surveys to be submitted to ERYC. Jim Record is happy to help with any Cave Road projects.

Feedback from ERYC is that they could not see why the village gate could not have been included in this year's application. This is something to keep in mind for next year.

Pond Update The pond has been cleaned out. From a safety point of view, the two head-walls at the stream will need to be repaired, although they are not urgent yet. The shuttering is rotten but do not feel this needs to be replaced immediately. Richard has sent a thank you letter to Mark Hornshaw thanking him for the use of skips.

Richard has spent approximately 48 hours working on the pond, stream and sheep wash and the PC agreed for him to submit an invoice for his time for £400.00.

Memorial Plaque – Richard has been in touch with the family who wish to have a memorial plaque for their mum in appreciation for feeding the ducks for many years. We feel families should make a contribution for this for the upkeep of the bench. We need to be mindful that plaques should be for people who have given their time to the village.

The family of John Redhead are going to contribute to the new replacement bench in his memory, and provide a new plaque for it.

Sheep Wash Damage – This has been reported to the police. Crime number 144591. Richard has cut out the damaged railing to make this safe. Martin Scott has some railing he will give to the PC to make the repairs.

Village Hall ditch, Hedges and Parking - We note that the pipe in the ditch near Burell Lane is damaged. The Village Hall ditch pipe has been found. ERYC are trying to find the owner of the field around the village hall to ask for the hedges to be cut.

Louise mentioned parking at the Village Hall at the recent Trustees meeting. The Trustees are happy for people to use the carpark but would not like to have a sign advertising this as the hall has regular bookings and parties and would need to be kept free for these occasions.

Christmas Lights – We would like to put a tree with lights on the village green. This would have to be behind the new planters from a safety point of view. We could look at putting up a barriers or chains in the future to prevent a tree being damaged.

Vacancy – We have had a notice on the website but not received any interest to date. We will redo the advert again. It was suggested doing a flyer advertising the position and add in a note about the village enhancements.
