Rev Becky attended the meeting to give the PC an update on recent developments at the church and future projects. The church had been closed for nine months and during this time all the windows have been repaired, the work was completed under budget allowing the extra funds to be used for future work. Whilst the church was closed some services were held in the village hall and hope this will encourage people to attend the church. The church will be open as a visitors hub for people/walkers to pop in for drinks and use the facilities. They are hoping to put a bike rack, a bench, and a bin. ERYC would not fund the bin; the PC could fund this and would cost approximately £400.00.

They held a successful music night and are planning an afternoon tea and hope other events could be held in the church.

The bench could be a community memorial bench for people who have played a part in the village and a financial contribution made to have a plaque place on the bench. We would have to limit the number of plaques.

New Waste Bin Request. This has been requested by the church and would around £400.00 as mentioned above. The PC are happy to do this once the bench has been installed.
