**Item 1 Minutes of the last meeting**

**Item 2 Matters arising and outstanding**

Pond Issues – The pond is full of water and now has some wild Mallards.

Ditch in front of the Village Hall – Drain Issue – This remains ongoing

Petuaria Revisited Dr Peter Halkon Petuaria Revisited – Arrange Talk in Village Hall. This will be discussed at the May meeting. It is hoped we can arrange the talk for some time in July.

Phone Box – Louise will ask if Rosie would like to do this, if not, we could ask Milan or his brother if they are interested in cleaning, de-moss and painting the box.

New Street Light nr the Post Office – The new light is up and running. This still needs to be painted. The light at Pond Cottage is waiting connection. RP has spoken to Peter Jacobson to ask how much it will cost to replace the lamps with LED and is waiting for a price. There is only one post in the village that is not a Victorian column, this could be changed if it is not too costly.

Hedges – If the hedge near the Triton is going to be cut back, this must be done by the end of February. If this does not happen, we may be able to do it outside the time scale as a road safety issue.

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Dale Road Bushes – George Foster was going to cut these back, but we note that ERYC have already done them.

Spring Litter Pick – Jim Record of Cave Road has offered to help. The Wolds and Riverbank Group litter pick is scheduled for Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> April. RS suggested doing our litter pick after this date to cover any areas not covered. We will also include Cave Road and Spout Hill. Possible dates 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> April or 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> April. This is to be confirmed.

Defibrillator – Battery checked and no problems to report.
