War Memorial - Ongoing

Sheep Wash – Bench/Interpretation Board – We are still researching into the possibility of purchasing a bench and interpretation board. In the mean time the area around the sheep wash could be tied up and re-seeded. Linda to contact Colin Mason for a quote.

Vacancy for new Councillor - Following the resignation of Chris Gilbert we now have a vacancy for a Parish Councillor. In order to fill the position the first step we need to take is to advertise the vacancy on the parish notice board. (Linda to organize). If we do not get a response we will be in a position to co-opt a new member.

Pavements – State of repair of the pavement on the bridge over the A63 and the crash barrier. Prior to the meeting these items have been reported to highways at ERYC.

Litter – (including around the bins in Triton car park). Again we note that there is a lot of rubbish around the recycle bins. Tina has spent some time cleaning up the area.
