Item 1 Minutes of the last meeting

These were accepted as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

Item 2 Matters arising and outstanding

Timber barrier to Church Green. Mr Berriman attended the meeting to table his proposal, for the installation of barriers, to restrict vehicular access to the grassed and track area, to the front of his property, when snow is lying. It is hoped this will reduce the number of motorists using the track, particularly 4x4's and quad bikes, which allegedly, tend to race around the track, revving engines and generally causing a noise nuisance, often into the early hours of the morning. Mr Berriman has constructed a working scaled model of the proposed barriers, to show it's method of operation and how it would look.

The Parish Council do sympathise with Mr Berriman and in principal, agree with his views, however, there are a number of concerns and issues that have to be addressed before they could consider with the proposal i.e. parking, insurance, limitations on the amount of time the barrier could be closed.

It was felt that we should contact the ERYC legal and highways department, for advice and to arrange a site visit, before making any further comments.

Pond – Hugh has submitted an application, to the St Modwen Environmental Trust, on our behalf, to assist with the funding of the pond repairs. Should this be successful, we will then proceed to apply, to the lottery fund, for a smaller grant.

Hugh has put together the 1st Pond Newsletter which has been printed ready for distribution.

The newsletter is to be distributed around Brantingham Village, Cave Road, Brough Haven, Elloughton and Brough School's, the Children's Centre, Post Office, Local Shops, Doctors Surgery and WARCS.
