Pond – Tina has spoken to Ellerker Parish Council and ERYC to find out if there have been any developments regarding the Yorkshire Water investigations. It appears that Yorkshire Water is going to put a camera down a man hole close to the pond to enable them to check out the springs. We feel this may take sometime and we should push for the lottery funding.

War Memorial – Glenda has obtained a quote from Ashrose Group of £826.99 for the Memorial to be cleaned. It was agreed this should go ahead and money from the Environment Fund to be used to cover the cost.

Sheep Wash – The bench and board are both ready to be put in place. Before the bench is delivered we need to have the plinth and fixing in place so the bench can be delivery straight to site. We need to decide the best place for the bench to be placed and would be useful to have a site visit on Friday 4th March at 2pm for those who can attend. Mike will contact the builder to organize the base.

Notice Board – We have obtained a quote from Arien Signs of £400.00 for a 2 x 3 A4 notice board in oak. This is only for a standard size and would have to see if they could make a board to our required measurements to fit into to the existing space in the railings.

It was felt that if we are going to have a new notice board made we should try to find a local firm to make it for us. Linda to make investigations.
