

Brantingham Parish Council Newsletter July 2018

New Chairman of Parish Council: Tina Wyatt retired from the Parish Council in May after working for the benefit of the village for a considerable time, including serving as Chairman for about ten years. Richard Powell has taken over as Chairman, with Glenda Greendale continuing as Vice Chairman.

Vacancy on Parish Council: There is currently a vacancy for a Parish Councillor. There are typically 8 meetings a year. Meetings are on a Monday evening in the Village Hall, starting at 7.30 pm and are usually finished by 9 pm. Matters affecting the local community, such as planning and environmental, are discussed. The Parish Council pays particular attention to issues that might not be compatible with the Conservation Status of much of the village. Bottle Bank, Triton car park: The Parish Council receives payment from ERYC dependent on the extent to which the Bottle Bank is used. This money is earmarked for environmental improvements around the village such as management of the village pond and conversion of the telephone box to an information point. Villagers are therefore encouraged to use the Bottle Bank for glass bottles and jars.



Boot Scrapers: We hope you like the stylish boot scrapers which have recently been installed at three locations around the village. The boot scrapers were made by Moore Bros of Market Weighton and are an exact copy of those at Goodmanham.

Work Parties: The Parish Council organises an annual litter pick around the village and occasional other work parties eg for work on the village pond. If you would like to help please pass your contact details to Linda Soulsby, the Parish Clerk (see below). The Parish Council is currently working to ensure that personal details are held in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Cave Road area: The Parish includes Cave Road and some other roads down to Brough Haven. We have plans for a new Parish notice board to be sited near the post box on Cave Road.
